



Population Census Results:

Conducted two population-wide censuses of nests: one in the incubation period (mid-July) and one after the hatching period (mid-September).

<p>Adults refers to the number of nests where one or two adult birds present, but an egg not readily visible. Lost Eggs refers to predated or broken eggs in a nest. Abandoned Eggs were found outside of a nest. Active Nests includes nests occupied by one or two adults (whether incubating or not), an egg or a chick. Lost Nests includes abandoned, predated and broken eggs that will not hatch, and dead chicks.</p>	

Nest Monitoring Results:

Monitored 29 nests and recorded the hatching dates and the growth of 21 chicks from mid July to mid Nov.

Hatching dates:

Aug. 1 -Sept. 8.

Mean = Aug 19 (n = 29)
